

# CHEMICAL MASKS



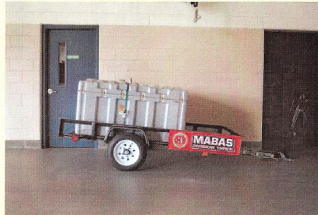
- Alternative to SCBA – Incident Specific
- 38,000 Purchased and Distributed to Firefighters
- For Use in Environments Where Oxygen is Sufficient but a Chemical Exists
- May be Used in Certain Biological, Nuclear, Radiological, Oxygen Sufficient Environment as Reconnaissance Confirms
- Issued with Spare Canister, Training Canister, Carrying Case/Bag and Spectacle as Applicable
- NIOSH Approved, Fit Test Applicable
- Divisions Issued Fit Test Machines
- Spare Bulk Canisters Available with HazMat Teams, Divisional Warehouses, Trailer Stocked
- Fit Test Machines
- 2010 Canister Replacement w/10 Year Life

# CAMEL BACKS



- Millennium Mask Support
- Hydration While Wearing Masks – Adapter Provided
- All HazMat Teams and Divisions Issued a Basic Quantity of Camel Backs
- For Use During Prolonged Operations or Where Use of SCBA's Impractical and Threat is Clearly Identified and Appropriate for Millennium Mask Use
- Personnel Decontamination Line-Support and Attendee Use

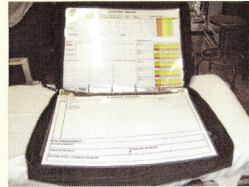
# IMT TRAILERS



- 75 IMT Trailers Field Deployed
- All MABAS Divisions Issued an IMT Trailer – Cook County UASI  
Divisions Issued Two IMTs Per Division
- IMT Trailered Kits Include All NIMS Required Material, Mapping Software, and Incident Scene Command and Control Support Equipment
- Kits May be Removed From Trailer and Carried Inside a Building or Shelter (Formal Command Post-EOC)
- Divisions are Required to “Organize and Maintain” Functionality of IMT Kit Contents



# TRIAGE “SMART” TAGS



- Computerized, Patient Tracking Triage Tag and Management System – Standardized
- Issued to All MABAS Divisions, Identifiable Private EMS Providers in Illinois
- Hospital Emergency Rooms in Process of Converting to “Smart” System
- Next Step – Computer Software Platforms and Field Hand Operated Scanners – Web Compatible

# EXPEDIENT FIELD SHELTERS



- All Divisions, Standardized Western Shelter/Trailer
- Approximately 130 Air Tents Available Within MABAS System
- Each Tent Easily Affords Sleeping Space for Approximately 20 People Each
- Includes Heating, Cooling, Lighting, Cots
- Interoperable With Tent City
- Powered By Generator Light Towers
- Applications – Decontamination, Patient Triage/Treatment, Field Offices, Housing of Emergency Service Personnel, Storage, Etc.
- Phase Out Air Shelter Tents
