

HOSE RECORD

All hose carried on the apparatus shall be listed by length number on a separate page of the company journal as a permanent record indicating the date of the weekly hose change or change because of a lead-out. This record shall be in the rear of the company journal. See Page 2 of attachment.

Hose shall be changed on day designated by Division Marshal

Engineers shall carry a book on the apparatus with all hose carried on the apparatus listed, along with the footage of each length, total footage and the date placed on the apparatus.

Hose is not to be borrowed from other companies without the consent of the Division Fire Marshal. Any borrowed hose in need of repair shall be returned to the company it is assigned to and sent in for repairs by that company. Duty Deputy shall be notified of any hose borrowed.


Division Marshals shall call the Repair Shops and arrange for the repair of hose when 30 lengths of broken hose are in need of repair in that division.

No length of hose sent in for repair will be accepted unless a shop tag is attached to the male butt with the tag filled out completely.

EQUIPMENT LEFT AT FIRES


